





Seniors who may benefit...

- Challenged dementia, including Alzheimer's disease
- Can no longer structure their own daily activities
- Socially isolated and desire companionship
- Cannot be safely left alone at home
- Live with someone who works outside of the home or who is frequently away from home
- Need assistance with Activities of Daily Living (e.g., dressing, bathing)



Some activities provided to participants on a daily basis

- Current events with discussion groups
- Mental stimulation games such as Trivia
- Daily exercises
- Activity circle
- Gardening projects
- Arts and crafts
- Music entertainment and sing-a-longs
- Daily doses of nostalgia
- Holiday and birthday celebrations
- Prepare shared meals and snacks
- Pet visits
- Outings to engage in the community (Extra fee may be required)

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
